ADMITTANCE TO PUBLIC SCHOOL: POST-GRADUATES AND INDIVIDUALS OF SCHOOL AGE

Category: Educational Services Effective: January 2022

Policy Statement

High school graduates who wish to upgrade or individuals who are nineteen years of age or older, who exhibit appropriate attitudes and interests, may continue to attend school, or return to school in accordance with the following procedures.

Procedures

- High School graduates who wish to continue to attend school or individuals aged nineteen years or older, who wish to return to school shall make application to the school. (See Appendix A)
- 2. Approval may be granted under the following conditions:
 - a. Space availability
 - b. Student attends regularly
 - c. Acceptable academic standards
 - d. Proper behavior
- 3. Applications approved by the school will be maintained at the school.

<u>Education Act</u> states: "school age" means the age between the date on which a person is required to attend school under subsection 15(1) and the end of the school year in which the person attains the age of twenty-one years;
