



**STUDENT DISCIPLINE – EXTRA-CURRICULAR AND
CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

Category: Health and Safety

Effective: August 2017

Policy Statement

Teachers associated with co-curricular and extra-curricular school events shall have the same authority over students as when teaching a class, regardless whether the event is during or outside of school hours, or whether or not the event is held on school property.

Teachers engaged in such activities shall be given the same support from the Principal and Superintendent in instances of student misbehavior (unexpected behavior) as if the misbehaviour had occurred in class.

Procedures

1. Teachers shall monitor the behaviours at all student-based activities in the same manner as they would at school (refer to [Appendix A](#)).
2. Teachers shall intervene to correct behaviours at all student-based activities in the same manner as they would at school.
3. Every teacher shall ensure the incidences of misbehaviour are reported to the school administration.
