## **APPENDIX H – Public School Student Survivor's Bill of Rights**

## A survivor has the right to...

- 1. Be believed.
- 2. Be treated with dignity and respect.
- 3. Be treated with sensitivity by all members of the school community.
- 4. Seek and receive assistance.
- 5. Be supported regardless of gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, age, disability, ethnicity, religion, academic year or program.
- 6. Be treated and respected in much the same way as any other 'victim' of a crime.
- 7. Ask questions.
- 8. Receive accurate information, presented in a way they understand.
- 9. Live safely both on and off-school grounds.
- 10. Be informed about all in school and community resources.
- 11. Have immediate access to health care within the community.
- 12. Choose whether or not to access available resources within the school and community.
- 13. Choose if, when, and how much to disclose and discuss experiences with others.
- 14. Have timely and necessary actions taken to prevent unwanted contact with the student who offends.
- 15. Thrive within the school community.
