As stated in my previous letters to you, the Anglophone West School District Education Council (ASD-W DEC) voted in favour of engaging a sustainability study of Kingsclear Consolidated School, under the process of Provincial Policy 409: Multi-year Infrastructure Planning. The sustainability study of a school follows a process that includes three public meetings.

Parents and members of the community are invited to attend the third public meeting in the sustainability study process for Kingsclear Consolidated School.

The DEC, at this meeting, will discuss and determine next steps on the sustainability of Kingsclear Consolidated School. A final report of the study is being prepared, and will include the items posted to the sustainability website and more.

It is worth noting that, at its public meeting on April 20, 2017, the DEC passed two motions in relation to the sustainability study. The motions provided an indication that the DEC is not contemplating closure of Kingsclear Consolidated School at the end of June, 2017 or June, 2018. Having said this, the DEC can present any motion for consideration at this public meeting.

I will write to you in the days that follow the May 4 meeting to share the outcome of the sustainability study for Kingsclear Consolidated School.
