Dear Parents/Guardians of Students at Millville Elementary School:

As stated in my May 27th and September 9th, 2015 letters to you, the Anglophone West School District Education Council (ASD-W DEC) voted in favor of engaging a sustainability study of Millville Elementary School, under the process of Provincial Policy 409: Multi-year Infrastructure Planning. The sustainability study of a school follows a process that includes three public meetings.

Millville Elementary School is a “triggered” school for study as it has an enrolment of less than 100 students.

Parents and members of the community are invited to attend the first public meeting in the consultation process on the sustainability of Millville Elementary School:
