Timeline

January 26, 2017	Anglophone West School District Education Council (ASD-W DEC) votes in favor of conducting a sustainability study on Kingsclear Consolidated School
January 27, 2017	Superintendent David McTimoney, on behalf of the DEC, writes formally to Department of Education and Early Childhood Development (EECD) Minister Brian Kenny, expressing the intention to conduct the Kingsclear Consolidated School sustainability study, as per Policy 409, Section 6.4.2
January 27, 2017	Superintendent writes formally to the parents/guardians of Kingsclear Consolidated School, offering an introductory explanation of the sustainability study process
February 3, 2017	Superintendent writes to the parents/guardians Kingsclear Consolidated School, outlining the process and providing key dates for public consultation and meetings
February 8, 2017	Section of ASD-W website established to house information and provide for public commentary
February 22, 2017	Superintendent meets with KCS Parent-School Support Committee (PSSC) to review information, describe process for a sustainability study and answer any questions to date
February 23, 2017	Superintendent writes to parents/guardians of children at Kingsclear Consolidated School to remind them of Public Meeting #1 on March 2, 2017; ensures public posting is in place
March 2, 2017	Superintendent meets with staff of Kingsclear Consolidated School staff to explain process; 3:30PM at KCS
March 2, 2017	Public Meeting #1 for Kingsclear Consolidated School; 6:30PM at KCS. DEC will tour the school at 5:00PM
March 3, 2017	Superintendent writes to parents/guardians of Kingsclear Consolidated School to describe the process for Public Meeting #2; outlines a registration process and parameters for making a public presentation as a stakeholder
March 28, 2017	Superintendent writes to parents/guardians of Kingsclear Consolidated School to remind them of Public Meeting #2 on April 4, 2017
April 4, 2017	Public Meeting #2 for Kingsclear Consolidated School; 6:30PM at KCS. This meeting will allow parents and stakeholder groups an opportunity to make presentations to the DEC and public regarding their thoughts on the sustainability of the school

April 27, 2017	Superintendent writes to parents/guardians of Kingsclear Consolidated School to remind them of Public Meeting #3 on May 4, 2017, in Fredericton (location to be determined)
May 4, 2017	Public Meeting #3 for Kingsclear Consolidated School; 6:30PM with location to be determined, in Fredericton. This meeting is where the DEC will bring the sustainability study to a conclusion through final discussions, a motion and a vote (Section 6.5.4)
May 5, 2017	DEC Chair Kimberley Douglas writes to Minister of Education and Early Childhood Development to formally advise of the outcome of the sustainability study (Section 6.6.1)
May 5, 2017	Superintendent writes to parents/guardians of Kingsclear Consolidated School regarding the outcome of the sustainability study and next steps
May/June, 2017	The Minister of Education and Early Childhood Development will review the recommendations (if made) by the District Education Council and, subsequently, respond (Section 6.6.3 and 6.6.4)
June, 2017	Superintendent writes to parents/guardians of Kingsclear Consolidated School regarding the decision of the Minister, if applicable, and next steps (Section 6.6.5)
June, 2017	Based on the final outcome, appropriate action will follow. This action could be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain the status quo • Invest in repairs for the school • Close the school and place students in another school
