2012 - \$11,255.41 (sewer) and \$1656.60 (water)

2013 - \$ 11,255.41 (sewer) and \$2145.39 (water)

2014 - \$11,705.63 (sewer) and \$1613.30 (water)

2015 - \$12,642.55 (sewer) and 1866.30 (water)

The sewer rate is a combined rate for both schools - the increases are based on a percentage yearly and I am not sure how the department breaks down the charges pertaining to each school. The water is metered and the water consumption since 2012 for the McAdam Elementary School is \$2,837.87 which is broken down on the invoices that are sent from the office. The rate increase from 2013 of \$3250 and \$6570. showing in the report was done by the department.
