MY WIFE AND I CONTINUE TO LIVE IN BATH WHERE MY WIFE WORKS PART TIME AT THE LOCAL BAKERY AND I DRIVE A TRACTOR TRAILER TO VARIOUS DESTINATIONS IN NB, NS AND PEI , WHILE SERVING AS DEPUTY MAYOR OF BATH .
