Interpretation:

The District Plan outlines the areas targeted for improvement by district staff.
- ASD-W will use the vision, mission and core values along with current evidence when developing the priorities and goals for the District Education Plan.
- The District Plan will include goals and indicators of success.

Compliance:

- Anglophone West District Education Council approved the updated mission, vision and core values in 2015.
- The District Plan will focus on areas of growth based on district data and evidence.
 Goals are established along with indicators of success. The areas of growth will reflect the established vision and mission.
- The District Plan will be a three-year plan for 2022-25, on the heels of two one-year district plans that have now been retired.
- Circumstances permitting, this year the Superintendent will undertake a
 collaborative process with DEC, district and school staff, and student leaders to
 review the current vision and mission and make a determination of any new
 direction we would like to consider, revising the vision and mission as necessary.
 The Core Values will remain in place. This initiative carries over from last year as
 the circumstances did not permit for an engaging and focused effort.
