

Anglophone West School District Snapshot – September 2022

- Covers one-third of the Province of New Brunswick in geography, Central-North-West (30 463 Km²).
- The Office of the Superintendent is located in Fredericton.
- Three Education Centres are located in the Town of Oromocto, City of Fredericton and the Town of Woodstock.
- 70 schools are located in the communities of Edmundston, Grand Falls, Plaster Rock, Perth-Andover, Bath, Florenceville-Bristol, Centreville, Hartland, Woodstock, Canterbury, Nackawic, Harvey, McAdam, Keswick Ridge, Burtts Corner, Nashwaak Valley, Stanley, Boiestown, New Bandon, Doaktown, Fredericton, Hanwell, New Maryland, Oromocto, Lincoln, Fredericton Junction, Geary, Burton, Gagetown, Cambridge-Narrows, Minto and Chipman.
- Two new schools are under construction or in a architectural phase (Fredericton North-East and Fredericton North-West).
- 23 610 students (September 14, 2022, unofficial enrolment)
- 1046 newcomers from 81 different countries (3999 newcomers from 117 different countries since 2016).
- 621Indigenous students from six Wostoqey Communities.
- \$260 M ASD-W Global Operating Budget.
- 3 877.84 employees, including 1 642.02 teachers/school administrators, 1 040.82 school based support staff, 696 casual support staff and 489 supply teachers.
- One Superintendent, nine Directors and two other leaders form the "Senior Administrative Team".
- The Superintendent reports to the District Education Council, with a sense of accountability to the Minister of Education and Early Childhood Development through the Deputy Minister and Assistant Deputy Minister. The remaining district and school staff report to the Superintendent and Director Team.
- \$14 M ASD-W Transportation Budget
- 35 000 KM of daily bus runs
- 17 663 students eligible for busing
- 307 buses
- Information Technology is managed through a corporate model
