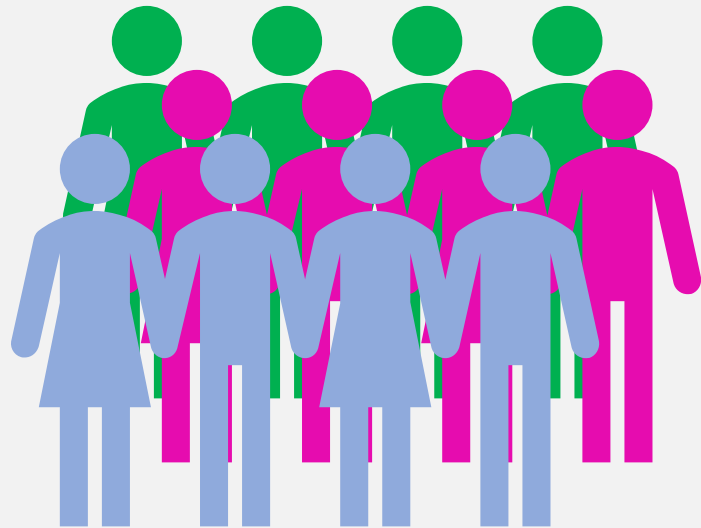

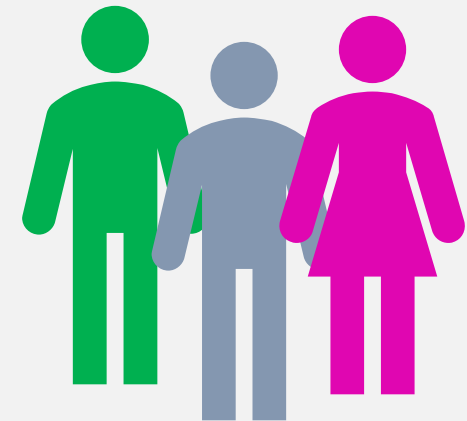
# Who are our Language Learners?



Most students move off language support in about 3 years.



After 5 years students are considered “long term MLLs” they may need more concentrated support especially with literacy.



Late arrival MLLs are high school aged but may need to stay until 21 to learn language and achieve NB Grad outcomes
