- 2/3 of Canadian Schools have no school food programs
- School aged Children spend 50% of waking hours in school
- 10.7% rise in retail food costs 2022, 4-7% 2023 New Brunswick
- 60% daily food consumption of youth aged 9-13 years is ultra processed foods
- Many Canadian families are reducing meal portions, skipping meals or receiving food from school/community meal programs (Food Banks, Soup Kitchen, etc.)

By the Numbers

Breakfast

- 51 schools (+ Enterprise Program)/70 school accessing free breakfast foods for students through the Food Procurement Program with NB Food Depot, funded by Breakfast Clubs of Canada and GNB. 19 schools left to be onboarded as soon as possible.
- Bi-weekly ordering, no shopping, no purchasing
- Students are offered foods from 3 food groups daily
- Schools also access PC Children's Charity, BCC, Rosemary Pantry, etc. funding
- \$409,500 additional third-party grants for food and infrastructure (BCC, ESIC, Rotary Clubs, Private donors)

- Most schools offer snacks to students and targeted families participate in the backpack program
- Programs are funded by various sources including Rotary Clubs, Private Donors, Charities, Food Banks, etc.

- Schools without cafeteria services but with hot holding infrastructure often offer a purchased, delivered meal service
- Schools with full infrastructure often offer an onsite prepared meal service
