

**2013** – Release of Policy 322 *Inclusive Education* 




**2021** – Release of Moving Forward – From Policy to Practice: Implementing and Supporting Policy 322, Inclusive Education








How does an ESST attempt to keep each student moving forward academically and behaviourally?



## Response to Intervention (RTI)


- Evidence-based
- A multi-tiered model of support
- For both prevention and intervention for each student
- ESST and classroom teachers work collaboratively using the RTI framework



## Tier 1

#### What does tier 1 look like?


- Teaching expectations
- Establishing classroom routines
- Offering choices
- Simplifying instructions
- Including a variety of activities in each lesson



## Tier 2

#### What does tier 2 look like?


- Small group instruction
- Targeted academic supports
- Extra practices
- Teaching replacement behaviours



## Tier 3


#### What does tier 3 look like?

- Intensive interventions
- Individualized instruction
- PLP planning
