# **EMERGENCY / CRISIS RESPONSE**

#### **EMERGENCY RESPONSE**

(school evacuation, bomb threat, lock down/lock in)

# **During normal working hours**

- 1) If applicable, call 911 first; then
- 2) Call the emergency line at 506-453-5333

The call will be forwarded to the Superintendent or his designate.

#### Line of Authority:

- 1) Superintendent
- 2) Director of Finance and Administration
- 3) Director of Schools at appropriate Education Center

Once contact is made with the office of the Superintendent, please follow your school-based plan. A member of the District Emergency Response Team will contact you to offer assistance.

- 3) Senior Education Officer at appropriate Education Centre
- 4) Coordinator for Guidance and Positive Learning
- 5) Coordinator of Support Services at appropriate Education Centre
