Superintendent Interpretation:

 Policy states that the Anglophone West School District Education Council (ASD-W DEC) will ensure community expectations and values are reflected in the work they do as locally elected councilors representing citizens in public education. ASD-W's vision, mission, and core values will guide their efforts as they work through policies and priorities. ASD-W DEC and staff are committed to continual improvement.

• Policy calls for the superintendent to ensure the mission, vision, and core values are considered when creating policy, setting goals, and making decisions that impact the district. This includes both responsive and strategic work (in good times and in bad times) completed by the superintendent and staff.

Justification:

- The vision statement shares what the district strives to achieve. It is a long-term aspiration and a desired future. The mission statement is action-oriented and reflects the present state and current capabilities. The mission statement is what the school district does and why we do it. The school district's core values are reflective of the mission and vision.
- The "District Education Plan" (formerly knows as the District Improvement Plan (DIP) and Positive Learning and Working Environment Plan (PLWEP)) includes a statement of vision, mission, goals, and values (Education Act 36.9(2)(a)). The District Education Plan outlines priorities, goals, and the areas targeted for improvement by district staff and the plan is monitored carefully.

- ASD-W uses the vision, mission, and core values along with current evidence when developing the
 priorities and goals for the District Education Plan and when working strategically for system
 improvement. Likewise, the vision, mission, and core values will be a staple in consideration of
 actions as the school district responds in times of need.
- The District Education Plan includes priorities, goals, actions, and indicators of success.

Compliance:

- The original mission, vision, and set of core values for ASD-W was approved by the District Education Council of the day in October 2015.
- Following an extensive, eight-month collaborative effort that included DEC, district and school staff, student leaders, and the public, a new mission, vision, and set of core values were established to better reflect our beliefs as a district.
- The collaboration included a final review of the current mission, vision, and core values by DEC, senior administration, principals, vice-principals and other district leaders.
- The DEC approved our current version of the mission, vision, and core values for ASD-W on September 28, 2023.
- The ASD-W mission statement is "To nurture learning in a healthy, safe, inclusive environment so students thrive and become confident, contributing community members".
- The ASD-W vision statement is "Each student is a successful learner who makes positive contributions to our world."
- The ASD-W core values include learning, professionalism, well-being, belonging, and citizenship.
 These values are further defined to allow deeper understanding.
- Posters describing the mission, vision, and core values are visible through the district. They are available in English and French.
- The ASD-W website clearly defines and celebrates the ASD-W mission, vision, and core values.
- School district leadership, with the collaboration of three DEC members, have finalized a new three-year district plan. Under the over-arching themes of "Learn, Be Well, and Be Respectful", we have set priorities of improving in numeracy, literacy, student well-being, and diversity. The 2025-28 ASD-W District Plan can be found on our website and will guide us in improvement.
